Here are a range of activities that Year 5 and 6 can be exploring during our Autumn topic. These can be completed and uploaded via Class Dojo, completed in the project book, or brought into class to share with others. Please continue to listen to your child read twice a week.

## Writing

- Research a chosen state and create a one page information text about it. What are the major cities? What is there to do for fun?
- Write a biography about a famous American


## Active

- There are 50 states in the USA- can you do 50 push ups? 50 star jumps? Challenge yourself to do 50 of as many different exercises as you can.

## Creative

- Research a famous dish/dessert for a specific state in the USA and make it. Write a review on how it tastes.
- Create a 'float' that represents a specific state in the USA. Which trees/animals is it famous for? Which famous people originate from there?



## Science

- Research a famous scientist from America. Why are they famous? What has happened because of their discoveries?
- Research Gitanjali Rao and discover why her work is so important.


## Maths

- Recap your times tables, including division facts. You should be able to do these speedily and without too much hesitation.
- Have a go at converting pounds to dollars. How any dollars are in $£ 10, £ 20$, £ 30 ?


## Speaking and listening

- Read aloud the lyrics to either the American national anthem, or a state's song. Discuss what they mean.
- Listen to music such as the blues, jazz and list your favourite songs. What do you like about them?


## Community

- Try to complete at least one 'Random Act of Kindness' every week- help out at home with a chore, offer to help an elderly person in the community, go litter picking etc.


## History and Geography

- What are the 50 states?
- What is different about South America compared to North America?
- Who was George Washington and why was he important to Americans?
