## Active

- Research a famous Olympian athlete and create a biography about them


## Maths

- Recap your times tables, including division facts. You should be able to do these speedily and without too much hesitation.
- Recap and practise using Roman numerals. Can you write your birth date using them?


## Creative

- Research and create a 3D model of a
famous Roman landmark
- Find a Roman recipe or traditional food and recreate it. Write a review about what you thought about it.
