| 1194 BC - 1184 BC | Trojan War | The Trojan was against Troy and the Greeks after Paris as Troy took Helen away from her husband the king of Sparta. A series of Athletic competitions held in ancient Greece for Zeus. Jesus of Nazareth was born between 6 BC - 4 BC. |  |

| 4 - 6 BC | Jesus Christ is Born | | |
| 1066 (14 October) | Battle of Hasting | Fought between the Norman French army of William the Conqueror who defeated Anglo Saxon Harold II |  |
| 1215 (15 June) | Magna Carta Signed | First written document explaining the principle that the king and his government must be above the law. |  |
| 1536 (19 May) | Anne Boleyn Beheaded | The second wife of Henry VIII, Beheading for treason and adultery. |  |
| 1645 (4 June) | Battle of Naseby | The decisive defeat and destruction of King Charles II royalists army by the Parliamentary New Model Army. |  |
| 1665 (September) | Great Plague of London | A disease that killed 200,000 people in London. Spread by rats. |  |
| 1837 (June) | Queen Victoria Crowned | Crowned at 18, Queen Victoria reigned for 63 years. |  |
| 1945 | World War II Ends | Also known as VE Day, was the day that Nazi Germany surrendered, ending the war. |  |
| 1969 | First Man On The Moon | Apollo 11 was the first spaceflight that landed humans on the moon, Neil Armstrong. | |

1066

Battle of Hastings

(1st October)

Fought between the Norman French army of William the Conqueror



who defeated Anglo Saxon Harold II. First written document explaining the Principle that the king and his government wasn't above the law.

1215

Magna Carta Signed

(15 June)

The second wife of Henry VIII, Beheading for treason and adultery.



1536

Anne Boleyn Beheaded

(19 May)



1645 — Battle of Naseby
(14 June)

The decisive defeat and destruction of King Charles II royalists army by The Parliamentary New Model Army.



1655 — Great Plague of London
(September)

A disease that killed 200,000 people in London, Spread by rats.



1838 — Queen Victoria Crowned
(28 June)

Crowned at 18, Queen Victoria reigned for 63 years.



1945 — World War II Ends
(7 May)

Also known as VE day, was the day that Nazi Germany surrendered, ending the war.



1969 — First Man On The Moon
(21 July)

Apollo 11 was the first spaceflight that landed humans on the moon, Neil Armstrong.



2015 — Queen Elizabeth II Becomes
(9 September) Longest Reigning Monarch
In Britain

At 63 years and 7 months The Queen passes the record set by her Great Great Grandmother Queen Victoria.
