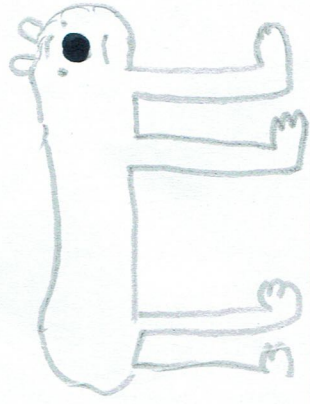

Polar bears



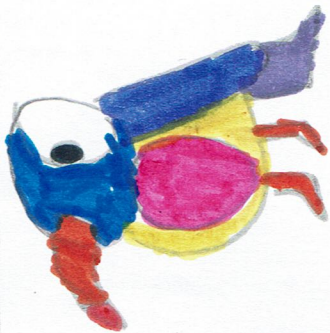
Polar bears warm, white fur enables it to keep warm in the cold climate and camouflage in the snow.
