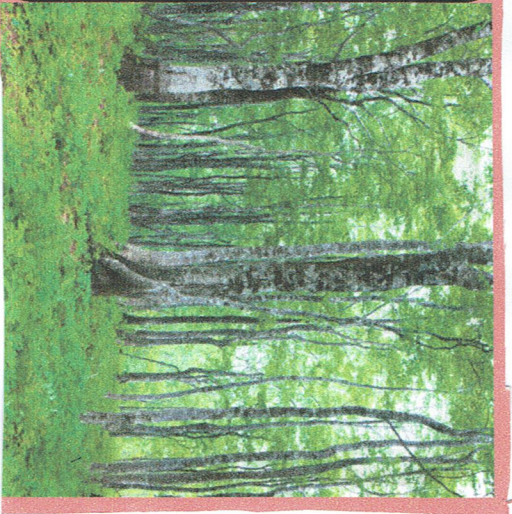


# Woodland

# Mice habitats!

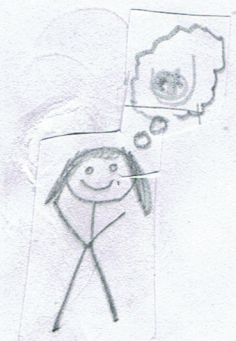
We found a mice nest in our garden shed this is the process:
