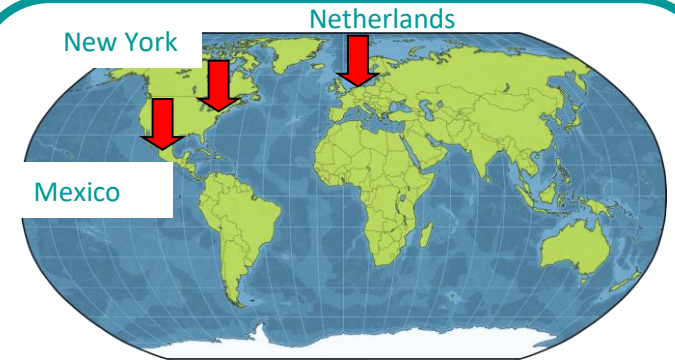
Key facts

Frida Kahlo was a Mexican painter. She mostly painted self-portraits and still-life pictures on tin sheets and, later, canvases.

Piet Mondrian was a Dutch painter, born in the Netherlands. Throughout his life, his style gradually changed from realistic to more abstract.
