Creative

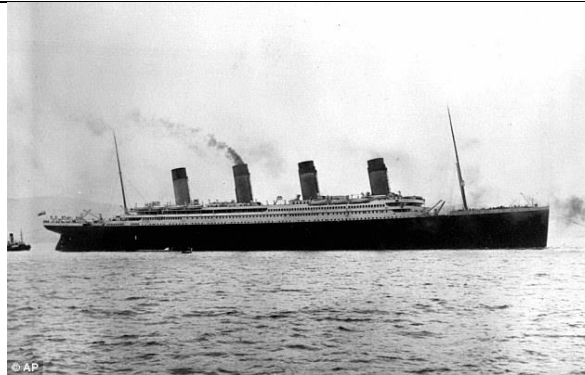
- Create an image of an iceberg using collage, pastels, pencils, paint
