<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write about a walk or day visit that you have been on • Write about your local area and what you like/dislike about it • Write a story about some of the wildlife that lives in your local area • Write a letter or postcard describing either your local area or a place you have visited recently. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw what your house looks like • Create an image (draw, paint, collage, pastels) of a landmark from your local area • Create a replica of a local (or national) landmark • Create an image of the local wildlife 	<p style="text-align: center;">Speaking and listening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record a video of yourself speaking about where you live. Can you use the words 'village', 'town', 'city', 'urban', 'rural' • Record a video of yourself reporting the weather in your local area
<p style="text-align: center;">Active</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go for a walk/bike ride in your local area • Go for a sensory walk- what can you smell/see/hear/feel/taste? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit a local landmark • Go for a walk/bike ride with your family to a new place in Northamptonshire that you haven't been to before 	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Our Local Area Year 1 and 2 Homework Projects</p> </div>	<p style="text-align: center;">Community</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk with older members of the family/community about their lives when they were younger and where they lived. • Offer help to a member of the community. This could just be litter picking or making something for someone in your community.
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise counting to 30 (Year 1) and to 100 (Year 2) • Practise addition and subtraction to 20 (Year 1) and to 50 (Year 2) • Year 2- practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find natural shapes in the woods • Make numbers using natural materials (sticks, leaves, stones) 	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go for a walk and find a variety of different leaf colours. Why are they changing colours? • Go for a walk and look for wildlife in your local area- where do they live? What do they eat? 	<p style="text-align: center;">History and Geography</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look into who used to live in your house: how far back in history can you find? • Research images of Naseby (or your village/town!) from the past. How has it changed? What is similar? • Use a map to guide yourself on a walk around your local area. What do the symbols mean? • Create a map for an imaginary place (from a story, or your imagination!)
