Rural

Urban

A place with lots of buildings close together and not many green spaces within it.

Village

A village is usually surrounded by fields and it might have a doctors surgery, a few shops and a primary school.

Town

A town is larger than a village. It might have more than 1 school or doctors surgery and it will have more shops.

City

A city might have a university, a hospital and will have lots of tall buildings.
