Communication and Language

- Sharing stories (listening and talking)
- Talking about new routines and class experiences
- Singing familiar songs and learning new ones.
- Talking and listening in 'big group times'.

Physical Development

- Using tools safely and with developing control. (i.e., scissors)
- Holding a pencil with some control and comfortably.
- Exploring wheeled toys.
- Taking part in weekly PE sessions with Pacesetters sports coach.
- Exploring yoga with Mrs Chamberlain.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Making new friends and learning how to take turns.
- Understanding our classroom expectations (e.g., snack time, tidying up etc.)
- Whole class PSHE sessions with Mrs Chamberlain exploring and discussing their similarities and differences, their feelings, and the special people in their lives.



Literacy

- Lots of opportunities to make marks, write and draw (e.g., name writing, chalks outside, and paint brushes).
- Understanding that print has meaning and sequencing pages.
- Exploring rhyming words.
- Daily phonics sessions using Read, Write, Inc.

Understanding the World

- Learning about our 'Busy Bodies' and what they can do.
- Singing 'Body Songs'.
- Learning to name the main body parts.
- Talking about people in their family.
- Exploring outdoors using our senses.

Mathematics

- Counting rhymes and songs.
- Using counting opportunities in the environment (e.g., counting in the line).
- Using the 'White Rose' maths scheme (Looking in depth at 1,2,3)
- Finding ways to represent and compare numbers and quantities.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Developing our own ideas in role play and 'pretending'.
- Recalling familiar songs.
- Exploring handheld percussion instruments.
- Using a variety of media (e.g., paint, collage materials, pencils to create own designs).
