Maths – Consolidation/recap week 1 of 2

Focus on the four operations

Year 2

Recap the following:

Writing numbers as words.

Adding three 1-digit numbers

Adding and Subtracting a 2-digit number and 1's

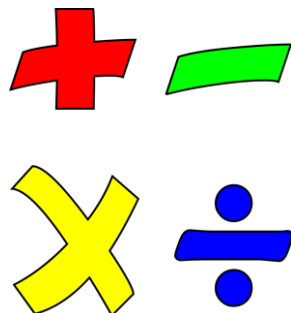
Adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers (Including sums where numbers cross over into the next 10 and where numbers need to be carried or exchanged)

Recap the 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables.

Year 3

Like Year 2 but also using numbers up to 1,000.

Recap the 3, 4, and 8 times tables.



Literacy

1. Write a persuasive letter to the Roman leaders convincing them that invading Britain is a good idea.
2. Write a diary entry of a Gladiator.
