### Maths – Consolidation/recap week 2 of 2

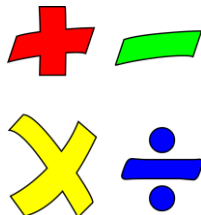
Focus on the four operations

(We will be moving on to Measurement – Mass, capacity and temperature after half term. I recommend holding on to bottles and other similar containers as these can make great resources)

Year 2

Recap the following: (Focussing mainly on 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables)

- Recognise equal groups
- Make your own equal groups
- Add equal groups
- Multiplication sentences using the 'x' symbol
- Use arrays



Year 3

Recap the following: (Focussing mainly on 3, 4 and 8 times tables)

- Comparing statements ( $<$   $>$   $=$ )
- Related calculations ( $8 \times 2 = 16$  so,  $80 \times 2 = 160$ )
- Formal multiplication (repeated addition, grid method or long multiplication).
- Divide 2-digits by 1 digit (bus stop method also known as long division).
- How many ways/possible answers? Problem solving.
