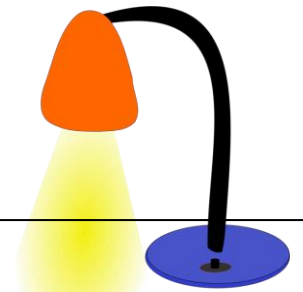

Maths – Time

Year 2 LO:

- Converting time – Hours and days
- Telling the time – Quarter past, quarter to and telling the time to 5 minutes.

Year 3 LO:

- Telling the time – to 5 minutes and then to the minute.
- Begin to look at using digital time – am and pm
