

Class 2 Learning Objectives and Activity Suggestions

Week beginning 4th May 2020

Maths – Time/Recap

Year 2

Recap any work on time that the children need more practise on. Practise getting them to read the time and displaying a specified time to you on a clock. Do not rush this!

Recap the 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables.



Year 3 LO:

- Find durations of time and compare them. Challenge other members of your household to complete task and compare the times. This will also include measuring time in seconds.
- Find start and end times using hands on a clock to help if needed. E.g. The programme lasted 45 minutes. It ended at 'x' time what time did it start? The train left the station at 3:30pm and travelled for 50 minutes. What time did it arrive? Etc.

Literacy



- 1. Write an instruction page detailing how to be a super Roman soldier.
- 2. Write a newspaper article warning the people of Britain about the Roman invasion.
- 3. Watch this space! I have received lots of positive feedback about the Class writing challenge so I may well set another.

New Topic: The Romans

Find out:

- When did the Romans first invade Britain?
- Who was Julius Caesar? Who were the other Caesars who came after him?
- How did the Romans live?
- What was the Roman army like?

Draw:

- A picture of Julius Caesar.
- A picture of a Roman soldier.

Other activities:

- Dress up as/create your own Roman soldier outfit.
- Create a map showing the Roman invasion/ Roman empire as it used to be.

Please remember that these are only suggestions. Do as much or as little as you are able to.
