

<u>English</u>

During morning sessions, children will continue to be taught phonics using the Read Write Inc scheme.

As part of our topic on the Battle of Naseby, the class will be reading a range of books including 'In Every House on Every Street' by Jess Hitchman. We will also be exploring a range of poems and learning how to write a recount of a trip to Naseby!

<u>Maths</u>

This term, we will continue to use the White Rose scheme of work. We will be learning about multiplication and division (counting in 2s, 5s and 10s), fractions and geometry (position and direction).

Topic (History/Geography)

We will be learning about the context and events of the Battle of Naseby. We will learn about the geographical location of Naseby and explore some of the physical and human geographical features of the village.

<u>RE</u>

In RE this term, we will be exploring which places are special and why. We will learn about what makes some places sacred to believers.

<u>Science</u>

In science this term we will learn about weather and seasonal changes. We will focus on the changes we see in spring.

<u>PSHE</u>

The theme for PSHE sessions this term is 'Being my Best'. This will include learning about hygiene, healthy lifestyles and resilience.

Computing

The children will learn how to programme Beebots to travel along a 3D map of Naseby!

<u>Music</u>

The children will continue to participate in weekly sessions with a tutor from NMPAT. Children will have the opportunity to explore different musical instruments, developing their confidence of performing both individually and as part of a group.

<u>PE</u>

During their weekly sessions with the Pacesetters sports coach Miss Emma, the class will focus on multiskills. They will also participate in yoga sessions with Mrs Chamberlain.

Art and design

The children will continue to develop a range of artistic techniques, including drawing, sketching and painting.
