Bring your own ukulele - repertoire to include traditional songs, and modern favourites

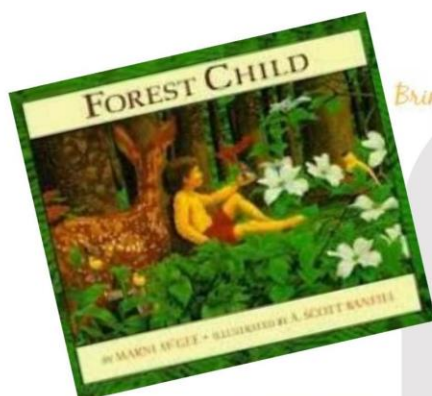
