

Fiesta Update



Naseby C of E School is a nut free school

Just a reminder that we are a nut free school. Children should not bring nuts, or any product containing nuts into school. Thank you.

School Office Hours

The school office hours are from 8:30am until 2:15pm. You can email the office at bursar@naseby.pfschools.org.uk or call 01604 740540. If you need to contact the school in the case of emergency after 2:15pm, please call the out of office hours mobile phone - number is **07795 568383**.

Reporting your child's absence

All absences need to be phoned into the school office before 9am or email bursar@naseby.pfschools.org.uk. Please include your child's name, class and reason for absence. If the reason is illness, parents should include details and expected date of return.

Lateness

It is very important that all children arrive on time. School gates open at 8:50am every morning and the gates will close at 9:00am. If you child arrives after 9:00am please bring them directly to the office where office staff will then mark them in the register and take them to their class. We ask that you do not take them straight to their classroom. If your child walks into school independently, please remind them to come to the office first to let us know they have arrived as this needs to be entered onto the school register for attendance and fire register purposes.

Leave of absence form

Please note that a 'Leave of absence' request form must be completed for any children who will be absent from school at any time during the day, during term time. Please collect a form from the office and return it for approval as soon as possible.

Fiesta Wrap around care



We are delighted to have started this term with our wrap around before and after school service at Naseby C of E Primary Academy. This will be available Monday to Friday for Reception to Year 6 pupils during term time.

3:30pm to 5:30pm

Activities

- a) Sports clubs e.g. Football, Dodgeball, Basketball, Dance and Scooter club OR
- b) Wrap around activities e.g., Arts and crafts, Science, construction, role play, creative play, reading, puzzles, board games, outdoor adventurous activities, and gardening.

Please be aware you don't have to sign up for the sports club separately. If your child is in the childcare option, they can join one of the sports clubs on the day if they so choose.

Booking - complete flexibility

You can mix and match activities each day and choose different times for different days. To enrol your child please create an account on our secure **MAGICBOOKING** portal. We recommend creating an account now so that you're ready to go for

You can enrol for the whole of the academic year or just for one off 'ad hoc' sessions if you prefer. Please note, discounts are available for longer bookings as well as sibling discounts.

Payments and Tax-free Childcare

School Uniform



School uniform helps to foster a sense of belonging amongst our school family and helps to encourage a sense of pride in our school. Uniform also promotes equality between children. We strongly encourage all children to wear school uniform when attending school and when attending organised school events.

- Boys: White or Jade polo shirt (with or without school logo) with plain, dark (black, navy or grey) school shorts/trousers and black school shoes.
- Girls: White or Jade polo shirt (with or without school logo) with a navy/grey or black skirt or pinafore dress. Summer uniform can consist of a green and white checked/ striped summer dress and black school shoes.
- PE Kits: White T-shirt (with or without school logo) and Navy or Black Shorts/Jogging bottoms with black trainers. Please do not wear any sports brand items (eg. Adidas, Nike etc).

Polite reminders

- Children with hair length that comes to their shoulders, must have it tied back at all times.
