## Class 1

**Reception:** It has been an exciting and fun-filled first week for the receptions in Class 1 as they settle into their new routine. We have had spent lots of time outside enjoying the wet play area and we have begun our new topic of 'This is Me!'.

**Year 1 and 2;** We have begun our new topic of 'Our Local Area' this week, discussing what makes Naseby special and comparing it to towns and cities. We have also enjoyed exploring non-chronological reports about attractions in London. Class 1 have particularly enjoyed being able to play with the older children on the paddock this week!





**In Class 2**; This week in Class 2 we have been learning about King John and The Magna Carta. Children have had a go at writing their own Magna Carta.

In Maths we have learnt about place value 10's, 100'2 and 1000's.

We have also completed a big write and looked at Henry VIII in our reading comprehension.

And finally we have started to learn about the artist William Morris.

# Class 3

**In Class 3;** We have been learning about the history of planet Earth. We used a cardboard tube to make a large timeline and placed key events on it. We started with the formation of Earth and realised that humans have only lived on the planet for a very short time (compared to the dinosaurs).

In maths, we have been learning about place value and how to read, write and order large numbers.

In English, we have completed our first Big Write and we all have a target to improve our writing. Check out our new class display that we have made.
