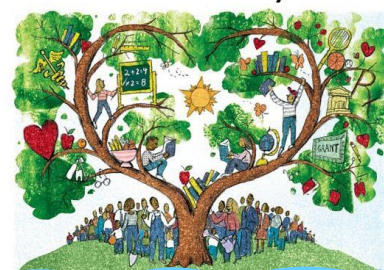

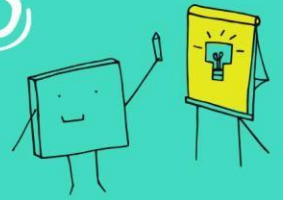

Class 1

We have had a busy week in Class 1! Reception have been learning about parts of the body, drawing around themselves and beginning to make labels. We have also been making patterns with shapes, paint and numbers! Year 1 and 2 have been mathematic superstars this week and learning that it is ok to make a mistake! We have also been exploring maps and pictures of Northampton.

This week Class 2 have built on from the knowledge they gained about skeletons, to also explore how muscles work. The children learnt that there are different types of muscles, some of which are voluntary and others which are involuntary. Morning workshops: What have we been doing?

Over the past 4 weeks, the children of Naseby Primary have been enjoying a variety of stories and drama activities.



Our **Tuesday Story time session** has been working on 'The Emperor's new clothes' and 'Aliens love underpants', both of which gave us opportunities to act out parts of the story- thinking about character, voice and movement. We also designed clothes for the Emperor, explored speech writing and wrote a letter to the aliens. Drama and English in one session!

Our **Thursday games session** saw the children improvise scenes from life- a beach scene where a crab caused chaos and a supermarket scene with a useless robber! Alongside this we have been playing lots of games to improve confidence co-operation and creativity.

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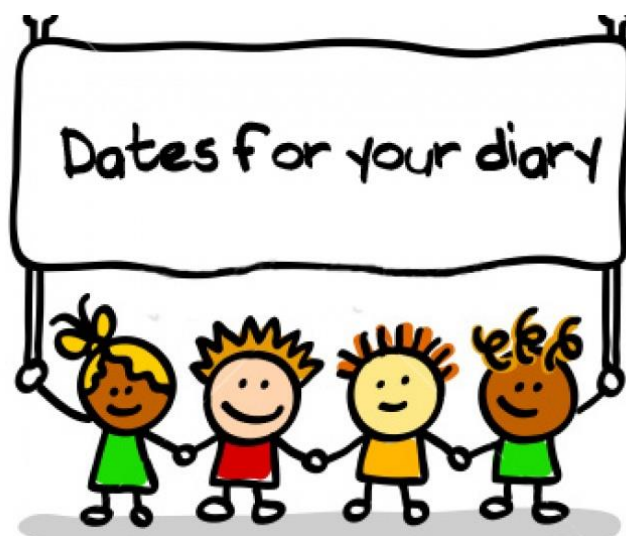
